

Telonics Collar Release Programmer - USB Device Software and Driver Installation

The setup program for the Telonics Collar Release Programmer (BCP-2) installs device software for the Telonics TSC-4A USB Interface Cable. You may see one or more of the following messages during the installation of the Collar Release Programmer:

Windows Vista and Windows 7 users:

Click the **Install** button if you see the following message. If you do not choose this option during installation (you instead click Don't Install), you will have to reinstall the Collar Release Programmer to install the USB device software. You can optionally check the box that says "Always trust software from Telonics, Inc." to avoid this message in the future.

Windows XP users:

Click the **Continue Anyway** button if you see the following message. If you do not choose this option during installation (you instead click STOP Installation), you will have to reinstall the Collar Release Programmer to install the USB device software.



If you see the following message during installation, you will need to modify your **Driver Signing** settings in Windows XP and then reinstall the Collar Release Programmer.



Right-click on the **My Computer** icon in the Start Menu or on the desktop and choose **Properties**. Go to the **Hardware** tab and click **Driver Signing**. Change the setting to **Ignore** or **Warn**. Click **OK** to close the **Driver Signing Options** window. Click **OK** to close **System Properties**.

Connecting TSC-4A to your PC (following installation of the Collar Release Programmer)

Windows 2000, Windows Vista, or Windows 7 users:

The USB device driver will be installed automatically when you plug in your TSC-4A. No user intervention is required. The Notification Area indicates installation progress and results:

If the Windows XP **Driver Signing Options** are set to **Warn**, then you will see the following message. Click the **Continue Anyway** button.
