

Telonics FP-100 Toolbox - USB Device Software and Driver Installation

The setup program for Telonics FP-100 Toolbox installs device software for the Telonics FP-100 Audio Volume Pedal. You may see one or more of the following messages during the installation of FP-100 Toolbox:

Windows Vista and Windows 7 users:

Click the **Install** button if you see the following message. If you do not choose this option during installation (you instead click Don't Install), you will have to reinstall FP-100 Toolbox to install the USB device software. You can optionally check the box that says "Always trust software from Telonics, Inc." to avoid this message in the future.

Windows XP users:

Click the **Continue Anyway** button if you see the following message. If you do not choose this option during installation (you instead click STOP Installation), you will have to reinstall FP-100 Toolbox to install the USB device software.



If you see the following message during installation, you will need to modify your **Driver Signing** settings in Windows XP and then reinstall FP-100 Toolbox.



Right-click on the **My Computer** icon in the Start Menu or on the desktop and choose **Properties**. Go to the **Hardware** tab and click **Driver Signing**. Change the setting to **Ignore** or **Warn**. Click **OK** to close the **Driver Signing Options** window. Click **OK** to close **System Properties**.
